Whereas, orders / circulars / instructions have been issued from time to time from this office with regard to the subject and reference cited above for checking the further transmission of virus and breaking of chain in spreading; and

Whereas, persons having travel history (foreign / outside UT) or have met with the suspects have been tested positive belonging to **Garhi area of Tehsil and District Udhampur**, as such the area has become more vulnerable as far as further transmission of the COVID-19 is concerned; and

Whereas, it is necessitated to break further transmission of disease in the area and it becomes imperative to take stringent precautionary measures like declaring some urban settlement as Containment / Red Zone and surrounding area as Buffer Zone.

Now therefore, in view of the above, I, Dr. Piyush Singla, IAS, District Magistrate Udhampur by virtue of powers vested under the provisions of Section 144 CrPC, the National Disaster Management Act, 2005 and the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897 do hereby order as follows: -

1. That the **Garhi area of Tehsil and District Udhampur** is declared as Containment / Red Zone.
2. That surrounding urban settlements of the Containment / Red Zone area are declared as Buffer Zones.
3. There shall be no inward or outward movement of any person from the said area and people shall stay at their homes and there shall be complete lockdown.
4. That there shall be no vehicular movement on internal lane connecting these urban settlements.
5. Tehsildar / SHO / TSO concerned shall ensure supply of essential commodities as per laid down protocols.
6. All establishments within the Containment / Red Zone shall remain closed.
7. It shall be mandatory for all the persons coming out in the area to wear masks.
8. Any person(s) / group(s) / institution(s) found violating the directions contained herein this order shall be booked under the provisions of relevant act / rules / law.
